Interns will be fully trained in all food and beverage areas and given the opportunity to train in supervisory roles. Elements of success will include knowledge of all dining menus, ingredients, preparation techniques and wine and beverage menus, as well as a complete understanding of daily, weekly, and monthly club events. Interns will be assigned tasks and projects to promote leadership and management growth. The majority of time is spent working with the Assistant Manager, Food & Beverage Manager, and Level 1 Food and Beverage Mentee to ensure that all club dining facilities operate at the high level Shoreacres is known for.

College students pursuing Private Club Management with previous Food and Beverage or Private Club experience, or candidates who have completed the Shoreacres Level 1 Food and Beverage Internship. Candidates must be able to work varied hours including days, nights, weekends, and holidays, with potential overtime.
