As COO/GM of Southern Hills Country Club, Nick has overseen three major golf course renovations and two multi-million facility renovation projects. Under Nick's leadership, the Club hosted the 1995 and 1996 Tour Championships, the 2001 U.S. Open, the 2007 PGA Championship and the 2009 U.S. Amateur Championship, the 2021 Senior PGA Championship and the 2022 PGA Championship. Nick was the president of the NCA in 2022.

David Chag, CCM David began his private club management career working 13 years at Houston Country Club. In 1987, he became the General Manager at The Country Club in Brookline, Massachusetts, during which time he oversaw four U.S.G.A. Championships as well as the 1999 Ryder Cup matches. David is a past Chair of the NCA and past President of the South Texas and New England Chapters of CMAA. In 2023, David was honored with a Lifetime Excellence Award by the National Club Association.
